

Seasonal Maintenance Checklist

Use this handy checklist of maintenance tasks, season by season, to protect your home and property!

SPRING

- $\hfill\square$ Trim back vegetation encroaching on the house.
- □ Clean gutters and downspouts.
- □ Check your property for termite tubes.
- □ Replace HVAC air filters.
- □ Run a sprinkler cycle to confirm it's in working order.
- □ Schedule a bi-annual maintenance visit from your HVAC professional.
- □ Clean or replace your stove's exhaust hood filters.
- □ Repair damage to the exterior of your home (roof, siding), and paint brick or stone.
- If you have a swimming pool, check for equipment or pool leaks, and have repairs made, if necessary.
- Wash your windows.
- □ Look for low spots in your yard, and install French □ drains to prevent flooding.
- De-winterize your plumbing, including outdoor faucets & drains.



- Have your heating system or HVAC inspected.
- Replace HVAC filters.
 Look for leaks and rust around your <u>hot water heater</u>.
- Elush your water heater and remove sediment to

- Check your roof for leaks or damage.
- Get your chimney cleaned.
- Replace or clean the range's hood filters.
- Touch up your home's paint, if needed.
- Trim your trees, shrubs, and bushes
 Clean up the yard of any leaves and debris.
 Disconnect hoses from outdoor faucets.

SUMMER

- □ Clean kitchen appliances.
- □ Clean behind the refrigerator.
- Clean out your drains using environmentally safe options.
- □ Inspect your patio and deck, and make necessary repairs/complete any maintenance tasks.
- Check under-sink shutoff valves to make sure they're working.
- Maintain your landscaping and gardening.
- Clean the outdoor grill.
- Replace HVAC filters.



- Check your doors and windows for air leaks, and seal.
- Caulk showers and bathtubs.
- Check your shower heads for sediment.
- Replace HVAC filters.
- □ Test CO2 detector, and replace batteries, if necessary.
- □ Winterize your plumbing, including outdoor faucets and drains, as well as drains in vacant homes.
- Clean and put away tools and outdoor appliances you won't need during the winter months.
- Check door handles, knobs, locks, and repair them if necessary.
- Test smoke detectors, and replace batteries, if necessary.

MONTHLY TASKS

- □ □ Change your HVAC filters.
- Inspect your smoke alarms, carbon monoxide detectors, and fire extinguishers.
 Clean your <u>garbage disposal and drains with BioOne drain cleaner</u>.
 Check for <u>scale buildup</u> on your faucets and shower heads.
